## The skills you need

- Enthusiasm and a good work ethic, able to commit to a minimum 10-days over the 6-week volunteer period.
- An interest in butterflies/wildlife and the environment.
- Desire to learn and improve identification skills.
- The ability and willingness to travel (own car/public transport).
- A reasonable level of physical fitness to access often uneven, marshy sites.
- Flexible and adaptable, due to changes in weather, schedules, unpredictable nature of the outdoor environment etc.

A timetable of available tasks and opportunities will be shared upon successful application and selection, however, due to weather and other factors, times, dates and activities may change, and flexibility will be required. We ask that you commit to a minimum of 10 days over the 6-week period, however there



will be the opportunity to do more than this and also continue volunteering beyond the 6-weeks. May involve accessing steep slopes, uneven ground, remote sites, and working with and around livestock.
